Alachua Habitat for Humanity Announces Home Dedication

Alachua, FL –Alachua Habitat for Humanity announces the completion of their 149th house. With Habitat’s mission to build homes, communities, and hope, homeowner Savannah will celebrate the dedication of her new home on **Tuesday, February 18th at 6:00 p.m.** The home dedication celebration will take place at **14482 137th Terrace, Alachua, Florida.**

ComSys, a proud community partner, sponsored the build of Savannah’s home with a generous contribution of \$66,000 in cash and over 300 volunteer hours on the construction project. The City of Alachua donated the property the house sits upon. The collaboration with Habitat, ComSys, and the City of Alachua continues Habitat’s mission to provide safe, affordable housing in our community.

Savannah serves her community as a dispatcher for the Alachua Police Department. She lives in an older home with her sister and mother, which experiences water intrusion with every hard rain. In periods of high humidity, their floors never dry out and their air conditioner works intermittently. Having affordable and safe housing with Habitat will be a large step in making her dreams come true. The reality of homeownership is possible thanks to the support of ComSys, the City of Alachua, Alachua Habitat for Humanity, and the numerous volunteers and community sponsors who donated time, money, and materials along the way.

Founded in 1986, Alachua Habitat for Humanity is the local affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International. We envision a world where everyone has a decent place to live and we work towards that vision by bringing people together to build strength, stability, and self-reliance through shelter.
